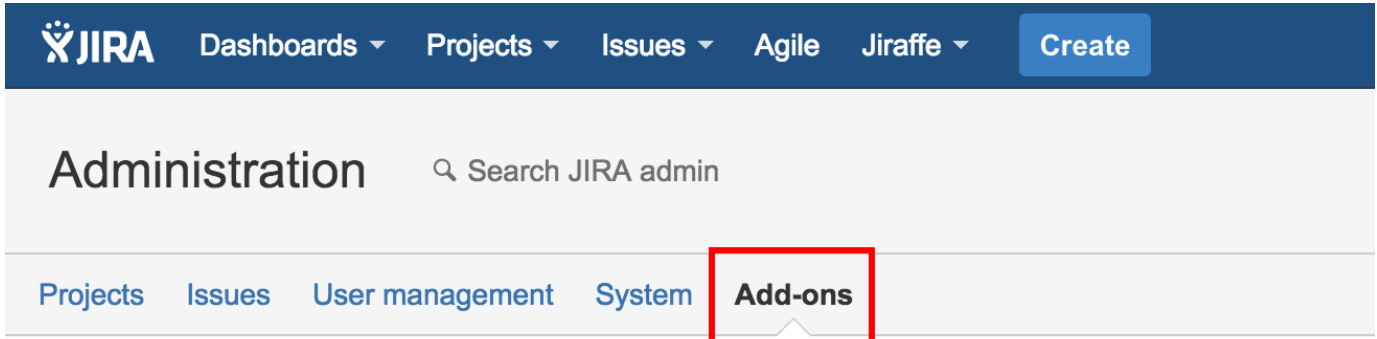


How to reset manually Jiraffe

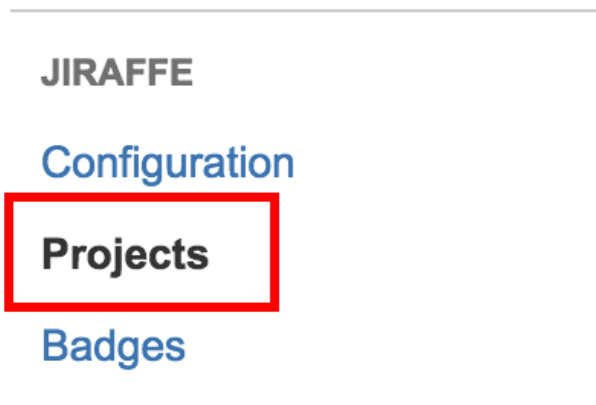
How to reset Jiraffe addon manually

All this instruction you can do with Jira running.

1. Execute `jiraffe-reset-mysql.sql` in your mysql or the file `jiraffe-reset-postgres.sql` in your postgres.
2. Remove the directory `/var/atlassian/application-data/jira/data/jiraffe/`
3. Extract the `jiraffe-data.zip` in the directory `/var/atlassian/application-data/jira/data`
4. Go to the Jiraffe administration
